SENIOR PHASE PATHWAYS — TEACHER INFORMATION EVENT

West Lothian Council presented on the Career Education Standard (3-18) and highlighted the expectations of practitioners in relation to vocational pathways for learners.

Finally, delegates were given an opportunity for Q&A and networking and received a tour of the Glenmorangie bottling plant.

19 delegates attended from 7 West Lothian Schools, who were predominantly Science Network Leads, Science Teachers, **Hospitality and Home Economics** Teachers - as well as Careers Staff from Cedarbank ASN School, West Calder High School, Whitburn Academy, The James Young High School, Bathgate Academy, **Armadale Academy and St** Margaret's Academy.
